Requirements for the Double Degree program “Vitis Vinum”:

- 1.) The filled application form for incoming students: Please see <https://www.hs-geisenheim.de/en/studies/international/your-route-to-geisenheim/exchange-students/> approved and signed by your home university
- 2.) Erasmus documents if applicable
- 3.) A Curriculum Vitae
- 4.) A certificate about the English knowledge level B2 of the Common European Framework of References (CEFR). The following certificates are recognized:
 - IELTS (minimum 6)
 - TOEFL (minimum 80 points; internet-based test)
 - Cambridge First Certificate - FCE – (minimum grade B)Knowledge of German is not required, but is strongly recommended!
- 5.) A declaration of consent of the coordinator of the home university (= “the university agrees that the student xy is allowed to study the 2nd year in the Vitis-Vinum double master degree program at Geisenheim University”)
- 6.) A confirmation about the successful passed 1st year at Torino or Udine (we need a Transcript of records of the 1st year as well with at least **60** ECTS)
- 7.) A confirmation about an 8 weeks internship in the field of Viticulture & Enology as a precondition for the application to the master thesis. Internships at the university can be accepted.
- 8.) All necessary documents for the registration at our university that takes place personally in our registration office:
 1. Valid passport,
 2. 2 Passport photos,
 3. A proof of Health insurance (e.g. European Health Insurance card),
 4. Student registration fee (approx. 330 €) must be paid four weeks before arriving in Geisenheim. This amount includes a study ticket for the cost-free use of all local means of RMV transport in the whole area and a contribution to the costs of the social facilities provided by the “Studentenwerk”. There are no additional study fees for incoming students. Information will be provided in June 2023.

Please send the documents regarding **points 4.) to 7.)** to the International Office (international@hs-gm.de) by **September, 1 at the latest.**

Please bring the registration documents related to **point 8.)** with you as soon as you have arrived in Geisenheim.

The personal registration must be done **by October 23, 2023 at the latest.** Please do not forget to transfer the semester fee 4 weeks in advance.
